## PITTSBURGH SAVOYARDS TO PREMIERE UTOPIA, LIMITED

The Pittsburgh Savoyards, western Pennsylvania's oldest continuously-performing theater company, are rehearsing the Pittsburgh premiere of Gilbert and Sullivan's *Utopia*, *Limited*, the second production of their 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Season. Performances will be at the Andrew Carnegie Free Library Music Hall in Carnegie, Pennsylvania from March 7-16, 2014. This classic comic operetta from 1893 – the next-to-last comedy from the collaboration between lyricist Sir William Gilbert and composer Sir Arthur Sullivan – is playing in Pittsburgh for the very first time. Fans of classic theater should delight in this unique opportunity to become a part of Pittsburgh history.

The production, which takes place in the mythical south-seas island kingdom of Utopia, is fully cast and in rehearsal. Veteran Savoyard Guy Russo begins his seventeenth year as Music Director and Conductor of the Pittsburgh Savoyards Orchestra, and the Savoyards welcome returning Stage Director Robert Hockenberry.

As usual, this production will feature some of the finest amateur and professional musical talent in the Pittsburgh area, with a cast of so many new and returning stars that many roles have been double-cast to accommodate them all:
